Below you will find information on our Centennial & Wetdown Celebration on Saturday, October 10, 2009—we look forward to your participation in our celebration!

The days events call for the celebration to start with a parade through the Town of Verona that will feature fire apparatus, floats, bands and antiques. The parade will start at Station 2 which is located at 209 Bloomfield Avenue—the east end of town and will end at Station 1 which is located at 880 Bloomfield Avenue—the west end of town. Station 1 and the Verona Community Center complex is where the wet down and the rest of the day's events will take place.

We plan to have the parade begin at 12:00 noon and should end at approximately 1:30 or 2:00 PM. Staging for the parade will start at 10:30 AM on Bloomfield Avenue in close proximity to Station 2—209 Bloomfield Avenue. Your travel plans should be aimed at approaching the Town of Verona from the east end. We have enclosed directions to help bring you in to the area so you come directly to the staging area.

Once the parade ends, you will be located at Station 1 and the Community Center where the Wet down, food, beer, music, kid's amusements and fire competitions for kids and adults will be held.

Directions

Directions to Verona NJ

We are located in the western part of Essex County surrounded by; Montclair to the east, Caldwell to the west, Cedar Grove to the north and West Orange to the south.

From Garden State Parkway and NJ Turnpike

Exit onto Interstate 280, take exit #8b Mt. Prospect Ave

Sign says Cedar Grove

(End of ramp stay in middle lane)

Go approx 2.4 miles and make a left onto Bloomfield Ave

(You will see an Acura dealer straight ahead and Exxon on left)

Proceed to staging.

From Interstate 287

Exit onto Interstate 80 east, exit onto Interstate 280

East. Take exit 8b, toward Cedar Grove. Mt. Prospect Ave.

(End of ramp stay in middle lane)

Go approx 2.4 miles and make left onto Bloomfield Ave.

(You will see an Acura straight ahead and Exxon on left)

Proceed to staging.

From Rt. 23

Take Rt. 23 south toward Verona. Make right onto Bloomfield Ave

(Acura on right, Exxon straight ahead)

Proceed to staging.

For those who may use alternate directions, please enter Verona from Mt. Prospect or Rt 23, Thanks you.
